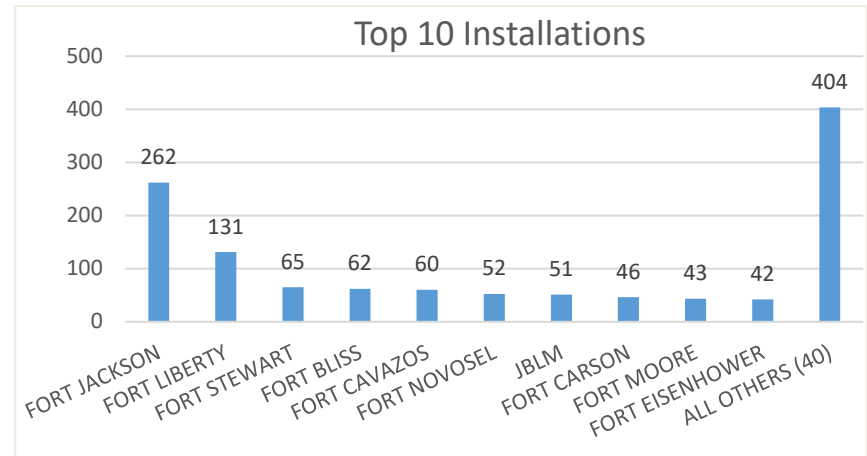
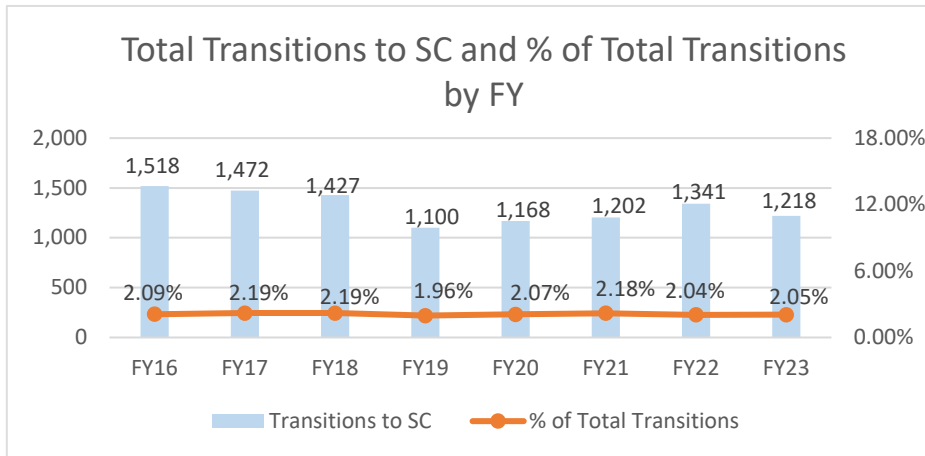


South Carolina ranked 15th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. 2% (1,218) of the RA population for FY23 transitioned to South Carolina.

*MSA stands for Metropolitan Statistical Area. A MSA is a predetermined land area that contains a population center with at least 50,000 people residing within its borders (Census Bureau). Some MSAs split states however the numbers only reflect those that transitioned to the SC side of the MSA. **ALL** data represents **ONLY** those with Honorable/general service.
 ** represents an installation is within the borders of that MSA.



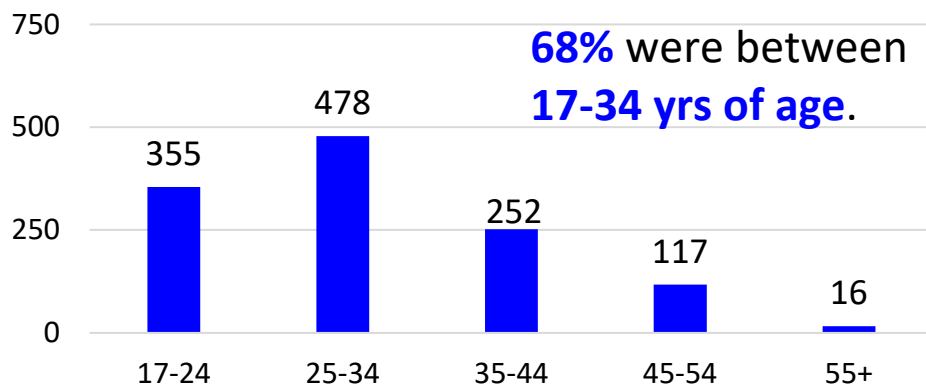

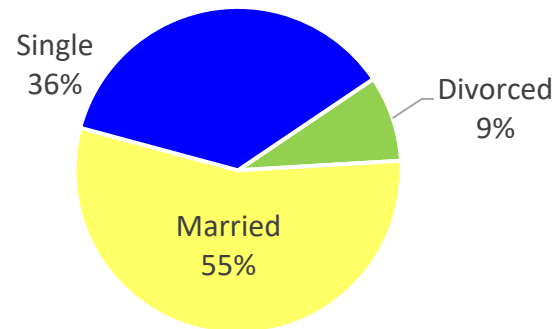
Demographics of the 1,218 RA soldiers that transitioned to South Carolina in FY23.

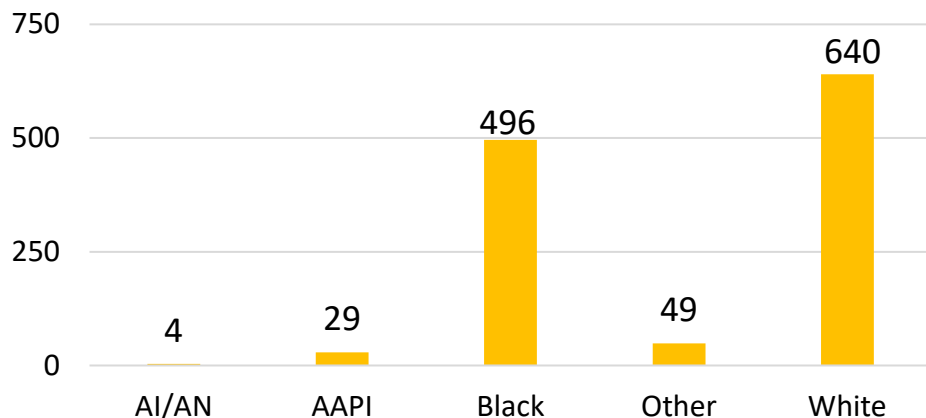
68% were between 17-34 yrs of age.



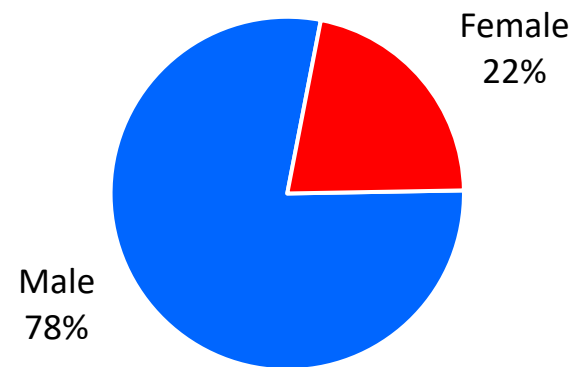
Marital Status

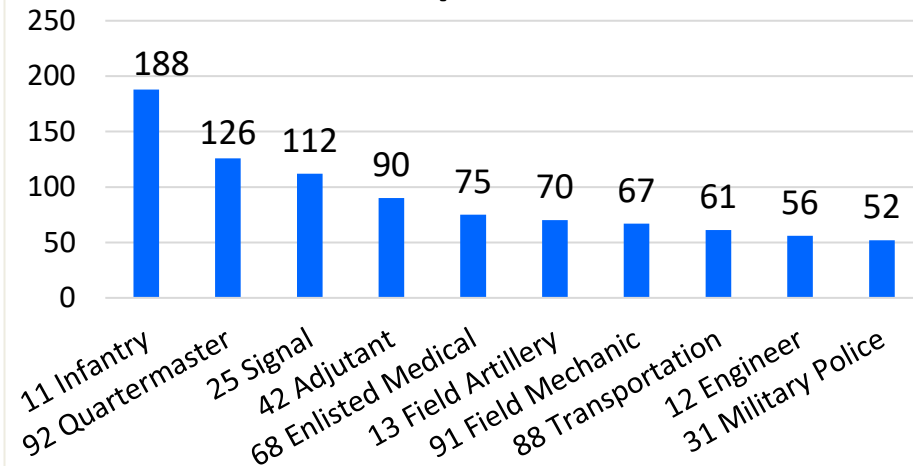

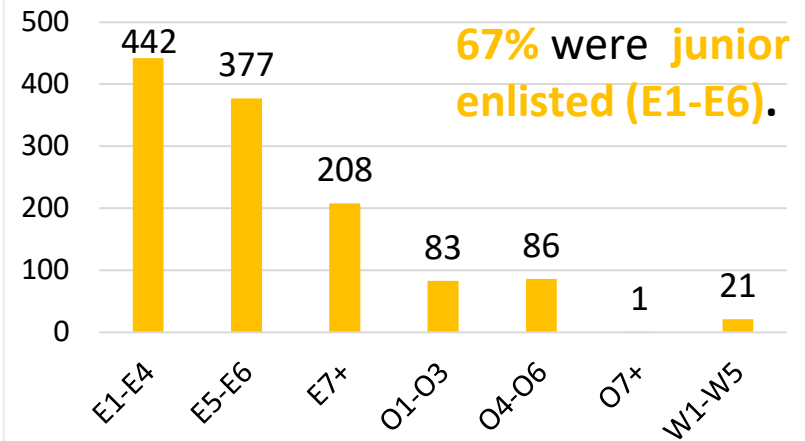


Demographics of RA Soldiers that transitioned to South Carolina in FY23.

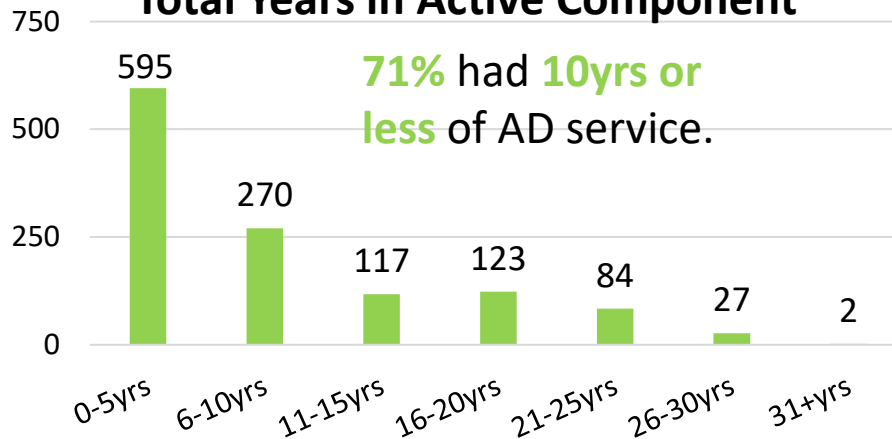
Top 10 MOSs
