


California ranked 5<sup>th</sup> in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. 6% (3,644) of the RA population for FY23 transitioned to California.

## **CA FY23 RA Transitions**

- $\gt{59,535}$  (left the Army)
- > **5,908** (Joined in CA)
- > 3,111 (returned to CA; about 47% loss)
- > 533 (outsiders moved to CA)
- **3,644** to CA











Demographics of the 3,644 RA soldiers that transitioned to California in FY23.
