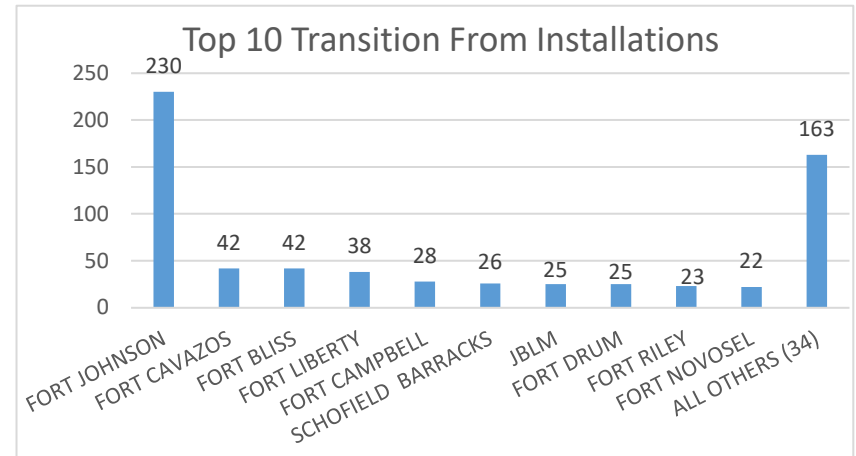
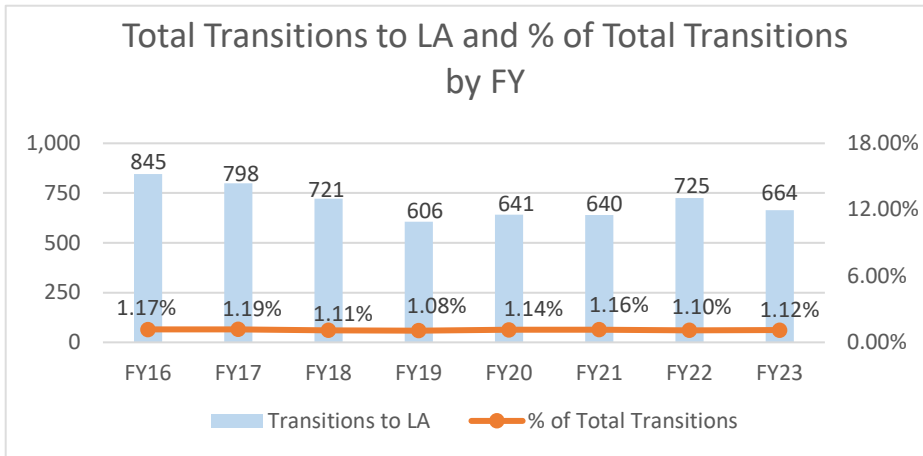


Louisiana ranked 26th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. 1% (664) of the RA population for FY23 transitioned to Louisiana.

 **represents an installation within the borders of that MSA.



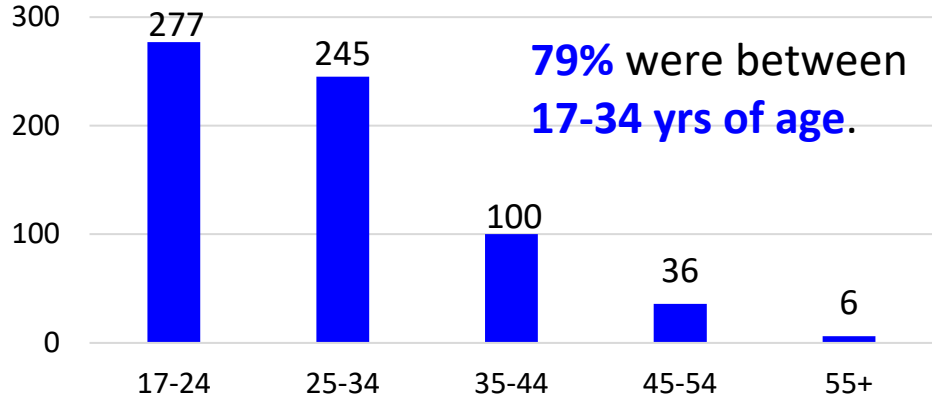

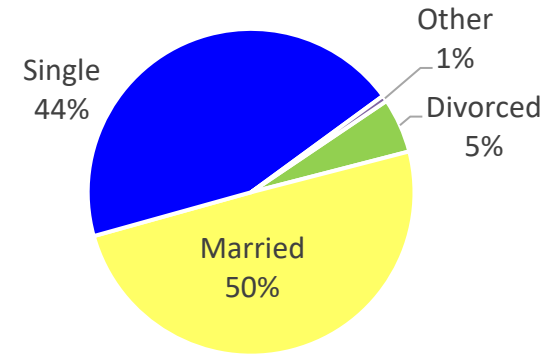
Demographics of the 664 RA soldiers that transitioned to Louisiana in FY23.

Age

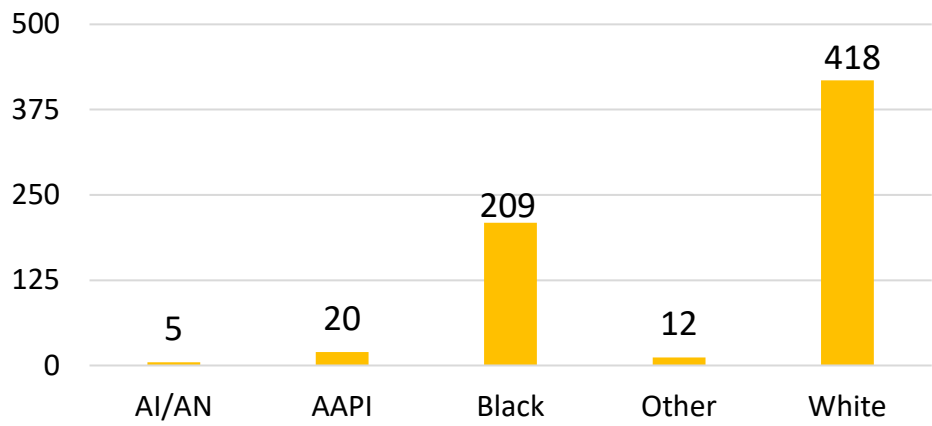
79% were between 17-34 yrs of age.



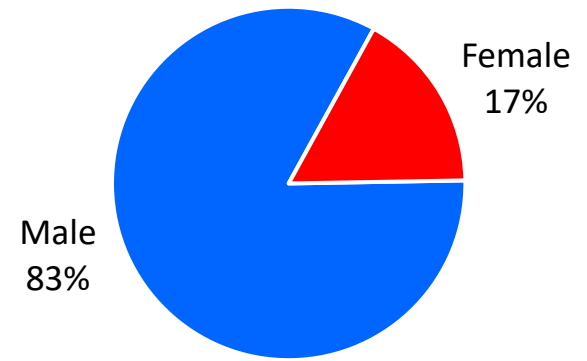
Marital Status
