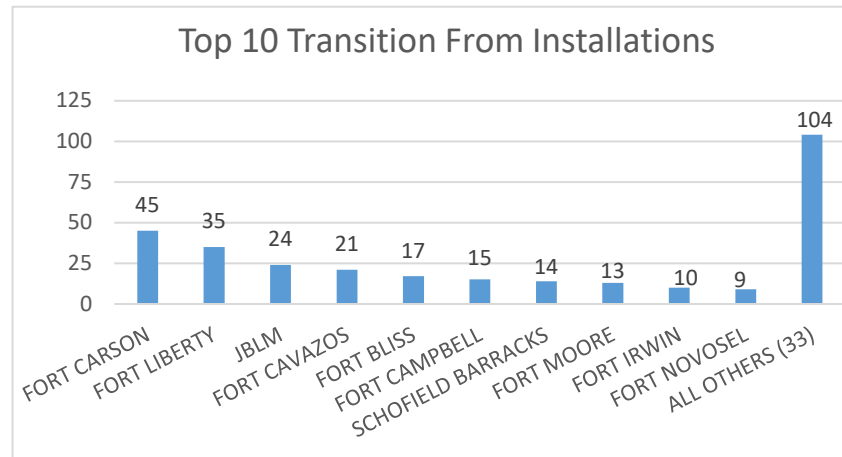
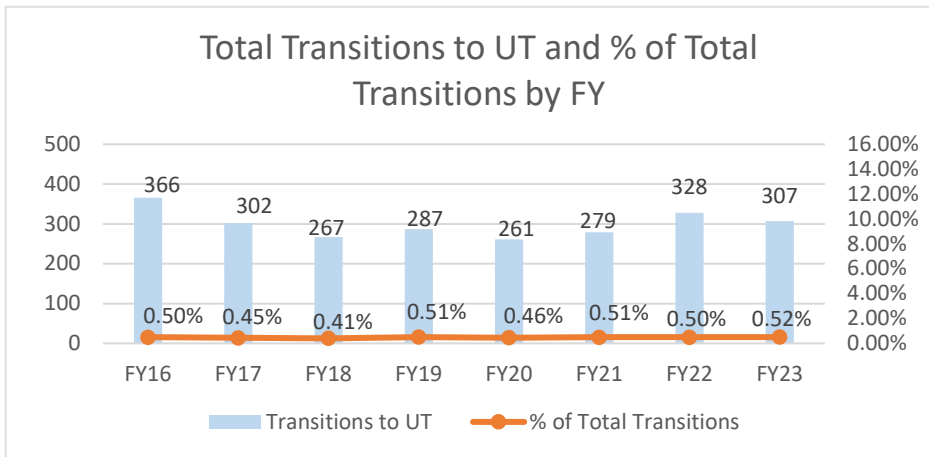


Utah ranked 36<sup>th</sup> in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. 1% (307) of the RA population for FY23 transitioned to Utah.

- ❖ **307** to UT



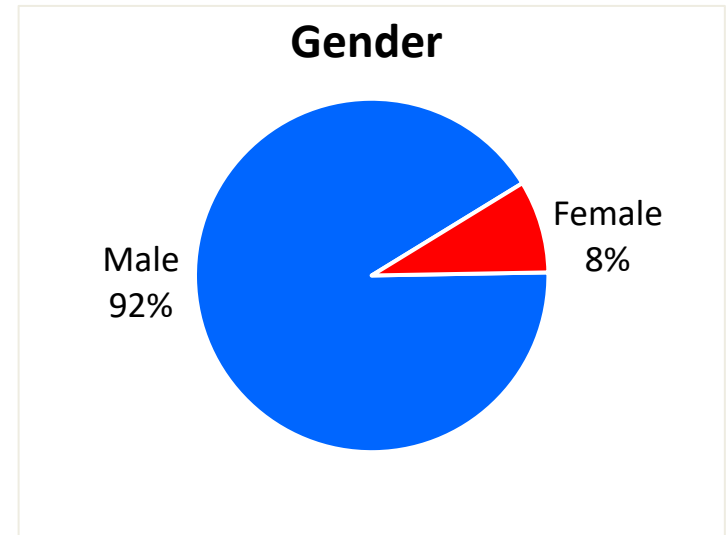
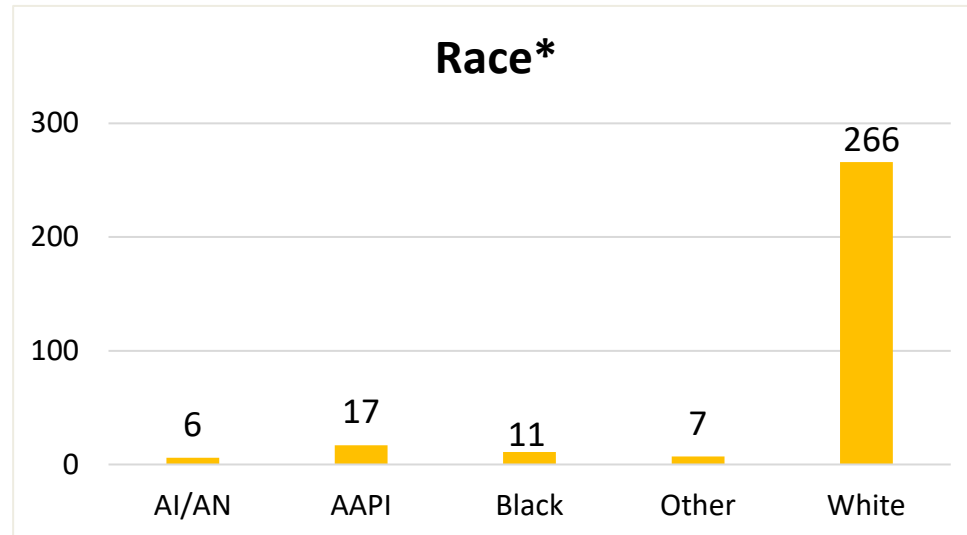
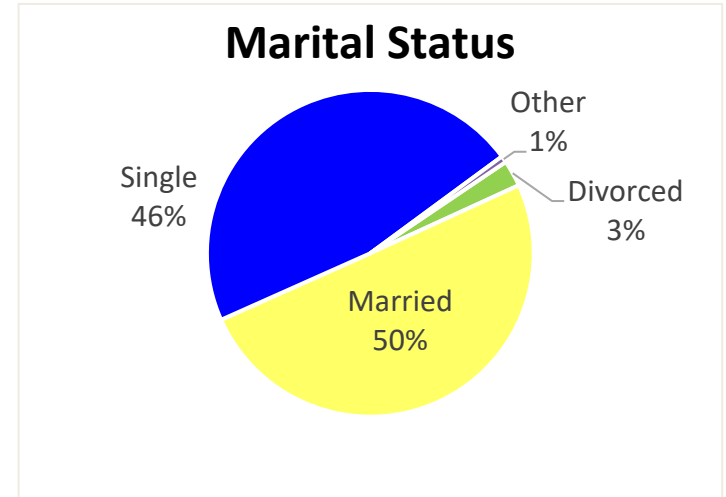
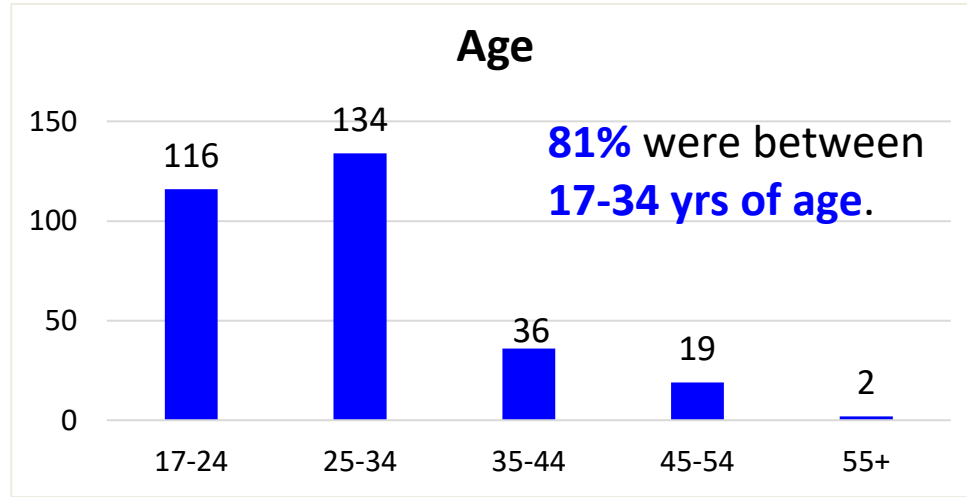

Some MSAs split states however the numbers only reflect those that transitioned to UT. **ALL** numbers are those with Honorable/general service.
